FirstLight Hydro Generating Company (FirstLight) is currently in the process of relicensing its Turners Falls Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1889) and Northfield Mountain Pumped Storage Project (FERC No. 2485) with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). In its March 1, 2016 letter transmitting 13 study reports, FirstLight included a schedule (see Table 1) for filing outstanding study reports and when it would target uploading the study reports to the Northfield relicensing website.

FirstLight targeted to upload the following reports to the website on June 30, 2016.

- Study No. 3.1.2 Northfield Mountain/Turners Falls Operation Impact on Existing Erosion and Potential Bank Instability
- Study No. 3.3.13 Impacts of the Turners Falls Project and Northfield Mountain Project on Littoral Zone Fish Habitat and Spawning Habitat
- Study No. 3.3.15 Assessment of Adult Sea Lamprey Spawning within the Turners Falls Project and Northfield Mountain Project Area

Reports for Study Nos. 3.3.13 and 3.3.15 have been posted to the Northfield relicensing website (<http://www.northfieldrelicensing.com/Pages/default.aspx>). Study Report No. 3.1.2 will be uploaded at a later date when complete.

On May 5, 2016 FERC issued its Revised Process Plan and Schedule. Per its revised plan, the three reports listed above are required to be filed with FERC by October 14, 2016.
