Re: Turners Falls Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1889), FirstLight MA Hydro LLC, Northfield Mountain Pumped Storage Project (FERC No. 2485), Northfield Mountain LLC Final Amendments to Applications

## Dear Acting Secretary Reese:

On February 22, 2024, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) issued its Ready for Environmental Analysis (REA) notice for the Turners Falls Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1889) (Turners Falls) and Northfield Mountain Pumped Storage Project (FERC No. 2485) (Northfield Mountain). In FERC's REA notice, it requested final amendments to the applications within 30 days or by March 22, 2024.

FirstLight Power Services LLC (FirstLight), as agent for both FirstLight MA Hydro LLC and Northfield Mountain LLC, the current licensees of the referenced Projects, is filing the following documents, as separate attachments, to complete its license application:

- A report entitled Supplemental BSTEM Modeling Report Reflecting Operating Conditions in the Flows and Fish Passage Settlement Agreement (F/F Agreement). The Bank Stability and Toe Erosion Model (BSTEM) was used to evaluate erosion in the Turners Falls Impoundment (TFI) under the operating conditions in the F/F Agreement.
- FirstLight's proposal regarding monitoring and mitigation for streambank erosion in the TFI.
- FirstLight's updated Invasive Plant Species Management Plans for the Turners Falls and Northfield Mountain Projects, which replaces those in the Amended Final License Application (AFLA).
- Revised Applicant-Prepared Draft Biological Assessments (Revised BA's) for the federally
  endangered Shortnose Sturgeon and Puritan Tiger Beetle incorporating the changes to Project
  operations in the F/F Agreement. The BA's also include the correspondence records with the
  National Marine Fisheries Service and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service on the Revised BA's.

To ensure all stakeholders understand FirstLight's final licensing proposal, Table 1 (attached) lists those sections of the AFLA that included FirstLight's proposal. FirstLight then highlighted whether the proposal measures in the AFLA are: a) replaced by the conditions in the F/F Agreement, b) replaced by the conditions in the Recreation Settlement Agreement, c) the same as the AFLA, d) new or replaced by amendments contained in this filing or e) are no longer included in FirstLight's final proposal.

As noted in its recent February 23, 2024, filing, FirstLight has requested a pre-filing 401 Water Quality Certificate meeting with the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MDEP). FirstLight will file its Application for Water Quality Certification with MDEP within 60 days of the REA Notice.

Footnote 1: The proposed Project Boundary adjustments in the AFLA remain the same. In addition, as part of the Recreation Settlement Agreement, an additional Project Boundary adjustment included removing 52.3 acres from the Northfield Mountain Project Boundary to exclude a portion of Farley Ledges that is not needed for Project purposes. A revised Exhibit G was filed with the Recreation Settlement Agreement reflecting this proposed change.
